One Point Medical is a modern medical practice focused on new technology and innovation. Our strategy is to create a centre of excellence for both patients and practitioners.


In addition to this, the practice has a stunning interior design with a “New York” vogue feel. Patients often say “It is like walking into a luxury hotel”.
